

Hospitalized Boy Has Bar Mitzvah

The Bar Mitzvah of Philip Levine, 13, a patient at the Jewish Sanitarium and Hospital for Chronic Diseases, will take place tomorrow in the hospital's Joseph Chaim Albert Temple, E. 49th St. and Rutland Road, it was announced today.

Philip, who has been afflicted with muscular dystrophy since the age of three, was admitted to the hospital in 1951.

In addition to receiving his grammar school education at the hospital's Public School 401, he has been a member of the institution's Cub Scout Troop No. 257 for the past two years.

His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harry Levine, are active workers at the hospital. Rabbi Solomon B. Shapiro and Rabbi Levi Belitzki of the hospital's staff will officiate at the ceremonies.
