DR. FICARRA HEARD IN ST. JOHN'S U. LECTURE SERIES

The fifth lecture in the series on psychology and medicine being given under the auspices of St. John's University took place yesterday in De Gray Hall, 75 Lewis Ave. Dr. Bernard J. Ficarra, surgeon, author and teacher was the speaker. He was introduced by The Very Rev. John A. Flynn, president of St. John's University, to an overflow audience.

Dr. Ficarra, a Knight of St. Gregory, is a professor of research biology at the university, and has contributed much to medical literature. He is a member of the visiting surgical staff of a number of hospitals here, including St. Peter's, St. Mary's, Kings County, and the Cancer Institute of Brooklyn Hospital.

In his discussion, Dr. Ficarra traced some of the relations between mental states and physical ailments and also touched on psychosomatic symptoms.

Sanitarium's New Synagogue Is Dedicated

The new synagogue of the Jewish Sanitarium and Hospital for Chronic Diseases, 86 E. 49th St., was dedicated yesterday. Approximately 500 persons, including many prominent lay and religious leaders, attended the ceremonies.

Rabbi Jacob Levinson, former president of the Mizrahi Organization of America, was the dedication chairman. Speakers included Isaac Albert, president of the hospital; Rabbi Solomon E. Shapiro, spiritual director of the hospital; Herbert Tenzer, past president of the Crown Heights Yeshiva; Rabbi Aaron D. Burack, professor of Yeshiva University, and Rabbi Louis Seltzer, executive director of the Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the United States and Canada.

The new synagogue, which is housed in a separate building on the hospital grounds, replaces the old synagogue which was located in the Max Blumberg Pavilion. The old synagogue was demolished to make way for additional X-ray rooms as part of the hospital's expansion program. New medical and therapeutics departments have been opened in some of the old buildings and in the recently completed new building.

Jewish Sanitarium Synagogue Named

The Jewish Sanitarium and Hospital for Chronic Diseases, 86 E. 49th St., named its new synagogue "Congregation Joseph Chaim Albert" in ceremonies held there yesterday afternoon. The synagogue is named in honor of the father of Isaac Albert, hospital president.

Albert accepted an engraved scroll honoring his 86-year-old father, from the hands of Rabbi Solomon B. Shapiro of Congregation B'nai Abraham. The elder Mr. Albert was present at the ceremony.

Rabbi Levie Belitzky of the hospital staff presented the president with a silver wine cup.

Speakers were Deputy Mayor Charles Horowitz, Rabbi Abraham I. Faivelson, director of the Rabbinical Board of Greater New York; Rabbi Meyer Sharf and Samuel Kaplan and Samuel Neimitz, gabbis (sextons) of the new synagogue.
