

Yavne Seminary Seeks \$250,000 For New Bldg.

A rally to launch the building fund of the Yavne Hebrew Theological Seminary will be held Sunday at 2 p.m., it was announced today.

The Seminary, a 31-year-old institution, is one of the most important in the United States.

The rally will be held at the site of the Seminary's present building 510 Dahill Road.

Among the prominent speakers to attend will be City Councilman Philip Schupler, State Assemblyman Frank Samansky, Herman Kaner, counsel for the institution, and Theodore Brooks, commander of the -JWV, State Department. Chairman of the rally is Philip Kurinsky who also heads the building committee.

Dean of the Seminary is Rabbi Jacob M. Shapiro who is assisted by his son, Rabbi Solomon K. Shapiro in the administration of the school.

As part of the ceremonies, a musical program will be presented featuring Cantor Max Bayer and the Sheldon Twins Orchestra.

Rabbi Shapiro said that \$250,000 is being sought to construct needed classrooms in the new building which would also serve as a youth center and a meeting place for general Jewish activities.
